MINUTES OF THE FREEHOLD BOROUGH HOUSING AUTHORITY December 7, 2016

Executive Director Joseph M. Billy called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. in the Administrative Office of the Freehold Borough Housing Authority. The following Commissioners were present: Commissioner Reginald Sims, Commissioner Stella Mayes, Commissioner Veronica Masi and Commissioner Lazaro Cardenas. Also present were Joseph M. Billy, Jr., Executive Director, Sharon Whetzler, and Ms. Lourdes Lucas, Attorney.

Commissioners that were absent: Commissioner Frances McDaniel and Commissioner William Cannon.

Executive Director Joseph M. REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR:

At this time, Mr. Billy, Executive Director reported on the following topics:

Mr. Billy informed the Board that Request for Proposal regarding Professional Services (legal, accounting, audit and pest control) have been advertised and be accepted on Wednesday, December 21, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. and present at the January 4, 2017 Board Meeting.

Mr. Billy informed the Board that the State has approved and returned our 2017 introduction to the Budget and the Housing will submit the final Budget with no changes for their approval.

Mr. Billy reported that a pin hole in a hot water pipe in the crawl space of Building 18 was reported. Mr. Billy informed the Board that the apartment located above the area had damp kitchen cabinets. Mr. Billy also reported that the new air vents will help in drying out the remaining dampness in the crawl space and will have the plumber inspect all existing hot water pipes in that building.

Mr. Billy informed the Board that the Election of Officers will be held at our January 4, 2017 meeting. A discussion will also be held regarding the Re-Organization Meeting to be held either January 22nd or January 29th.
